Attendance Commitment: 1 ½ Day Retreat, February 6, 2020 which includes community introduction/ issues presentation, community service introduction and team building. Remaining Leadership Tomorrow Program day sessions start on February 21, 2020 and finish with graduation on May 29, 2020. We generally meet for a full day, every other Friday. Program days begin at 8:00AM and end at 4:30PM with occasional time outside of class, especially for Criminal Justice activities. Class participants will be required to complete 35 community service hours to be served in Vermilion County, a written documentation (journal) of community volunteerism, and a brief, personal reflection paper is required. Attendance is mandatory at the retreat and at least six additional sessions for graduation.

Participants in the Leadership Tomorrow program must have the support and commitment of their business or organization. Both applicant and employer must sign the application as an indication on this support and commitment. The nominees must also have the financial commitment required to participate effectively in Leadership Tomorrow.

Class tuition is due on notification of acceptance into Leadership Tomorrow, 2020, Class 32. Tuition for Vermilion Advantage Members: \$750.00 (other discounts may apply based on Vermilion Advantage membership level).
