ATTENDANCE COMMITMENT: 1½ Day Retreat, January 2018: Day One – ½ day (afternoon) of January 18 on Community Issues/Personality Training; Day Two – Team Building Learning Course (all day January 20). Remaining Leadership Tomorrow Program day sessions start on February 1, 2019 and finish with graduation on May 10, 2019. We generally meet every other Friday. Program days begin at 8:00AM and end at 4:30PM with occasional time outside of class, especially for Criminal Justice activities. Class participants will be required to complete 35 community service hours to be served in Vermilion County, a written documentation (journal) of community volunteerism, and a brief, personal reflection paper. Attendance is mandatory at Retreat and at least six sessions for graduation.

Participants in the Leadership Tomorrow program must have the support and commitment of their business or organization. Both applicant and employer must sign the application as an indication of this support and commitment. The nominees must also have the financial commitment required to participate effectively in Leadership Tomorrow.

Class tuition is due on notification of acceptance into Leadership Tomorrow, 2019, Class 31.
