Meet the Executive Board of Vermilion Advantage

Danville Community Consolidated School District 118

First, tell us about your organization. Educating Pre-K – 12th Grade Students, approximately 900 employees and 5500 students.

What new things are happening at District 118? We have lots of exciting things happening! One of the most exciting for me is the implementation of a Grow Your Own Program for District 118 graduates going into the education field. We will assist with tuition in exchange for their commitment to work in Danville District 118 for five years upon graduation. Teaching Assistants employed by the district can also obtain their teaching degree with tuition assistance from the district. There is no better investment than the one made into our staff and students!

We are opening a health clinic at Danville High School. This service will begin with the DHS and KDBA students and will then become available to all students and staff districtwide for medical, mental health, and substance abuse needs.

There are several construction and facility improvements happening! HVAC upgrades for six schools. DHS updates include new auditorium lighting, sound, and stage rigging, new Science Labs, Learning Commons, Innovation Lab, Food Lab, tuckpointing, all-weather track resurfacing, new football bleachers, and additional security measures. KDBA will get eight additional classrooms, a new gymnasium, and additional restrooms and office space.

Northeast will get two additional classrooms, gymnasium, music room, and additional restrooms and office space.

Do you have any position openings? At this time, we have openings for assistant principals, teachers, teaching assistants, hall monitors, kitchen staff, payroll staff, custodians, tutors, school counselors, social workers, substitute nurses, an athletic trainer, and various other extra-curricular positions. All of our openings are listed on our website at danville118.org under Jobs at D118.

How long have you been involved with Vermilion Advantage? I have been on the board for eight years. I am working to be the bridge between our business partners and our students (their employees of tomorrow). We are working together to make sure District 118 students are given the skills they need to pursue higher education and/or join the workforce. We want to prepare them for either path. I am most grateful for the connection provided to us by Vermilion Advantage with local employers. When I spoke to all of my seniors last year, the initial goal was to ensure there was a developed plan for their goal of education or employment. This endeavor grew into a partnership with DACC and Vermilion County businesses. We created resumes, completed FASFA's, and submitted college applications. We were able to reach out to these Vermilion County business partners to secure jobs,

scholarships, or internships with various businesses. As the second largest employer in Vermilion County, I am also pleased to say this translated into approximately 32 summer workers, 13 additional part time teaching assistants, and 15 future educators for D118. Our students need to understand there are employment opportunities right here in our own city, so our talented youth consider remaining in the community.

Tell us about your connection to the area. My hometown is Roosevelt, Long Island, NY. I moved to Vermilion County when I became District 118 Superintendent eight years ago.

What do you feel are the top priorities for the city/county? One of the top priorities is always economic growth. As more jobs are created in the community, it increases the need for more families to move to the city. As a result, the population within our schools can increase. This same growth also increases the property tax base thereby providing more funding resources for the community as a whole and the school district. This results in the District's ability to allocate more money per student, toward their education. Another priority is reduction of violence, but that should be approached at the grass roots level with an emphasis on education, training and skills development, housing, job retention and creation.

How has the area changed over the last 20 years, and how do you see Vermilion Advantage's role in that change? While larger employers of the past have gone, we cannot ignore the reality that over the last 20 years Danville has seen a resurgence in economic investment into our community. This is true for large commercial industries, service-providers, and the small unique retail

businesses and restaurants. It is important to note, not only are large companies willing to create or expand in our area (capitalizing on the strong workforce development available through Danville Area Community College, high school workforce programs, and training development entities), but those small business entrepreneurs recognize our community as one in which they want to establish, build and grow. Vermilion Advantage facilitates these relationships, providing the means to guide any sized commercial entity towards success, highlights the advantages of our area through recruitment and retention campaigns, and offers information pertaining to valuable resources available to allow all industries to grow in Vermilion County.

Vermilion Advantage's team are the area professionals in the field of economic and workforce development, and recruiting and retaining businesses, while supporting established businesses. The organization is a great asset for our community.

What is one thing that might surprise people about you? That I have a great sense of humor and I really like to have fun. In my role as superintendent, I need to deal with major issues that impact our staff and students, (i.e. COVID, weather, and safety situations) so that is not the attribute I get to share very often. Parents need to see me as someone they can trust to be knowledgeable. I take my position and decisions seriously, so I don't get the opportunity to show that side of me very often. But if you ask the staff in my office- those who get to see me daily -- they can attest.

What's the best advice you've ever been given? In all thy ways acknowledge God, and He will direct thy path.

The Consult Offers Free Business Advice at the Danville Public Library

Peter Blackmon, Executive Director of the Danville Library Foundation, noticed the pandemic caused a surge in entrepreneurship born out of panic and necessity. “More people started taking leaps, but I know it is a fragile climate,” he says. Blackmon created The Consult in April of 2022 to help fledgling and experienced small business owners with no-cost advice from seasoned business professionals. “I’ve invited so many talented people to the table; it’s quite the firepower of knowledge,” he says. On average, about a dozen people attend each month.

The Consult is a collective of retired business professionals, active business leaders and representatives of business growth organizations who meet once a month, welcoming small business owners at every stage of their career (from potential new businesses to established area businesses and anywhere in between). The team offers free advice covering a multitude of

topics. “Whether it be a business looking for advice on growth or re-branding or simply ‘where to get started,’ The Consult shares career experiences and points people in the right direction on where to seek professional assistance,” says Blackmon. “We’re arming them with the right questions to ask when they do.”

“The Consult, a Danville Public Library Foundation project, is endorsed and supported by the Illinois Small Business Development Center at DACC, Vermilion Advantage, and the Danville Public Library. All consultants (seasoned business owners, bankers, lawyers, consultants etc.) donate their time to answer questions of the businesses.”

The service is free and offered at the Danville Public Library. “Years ago, Danville hosted a S.C.O.R.E. program

(Service Corps of Retired Executives),” says Blackmon. “It was a good program that went away. I wanted to bring that back. The re-emergence of a Chamber of Commerce and new attention to small businesses on the part of Vermilion Advantage needs echoing. I’m thankful for that and want to drive more people to utilize them and the Small Business Development Center via DACC.”

What would surprise people most about your business?

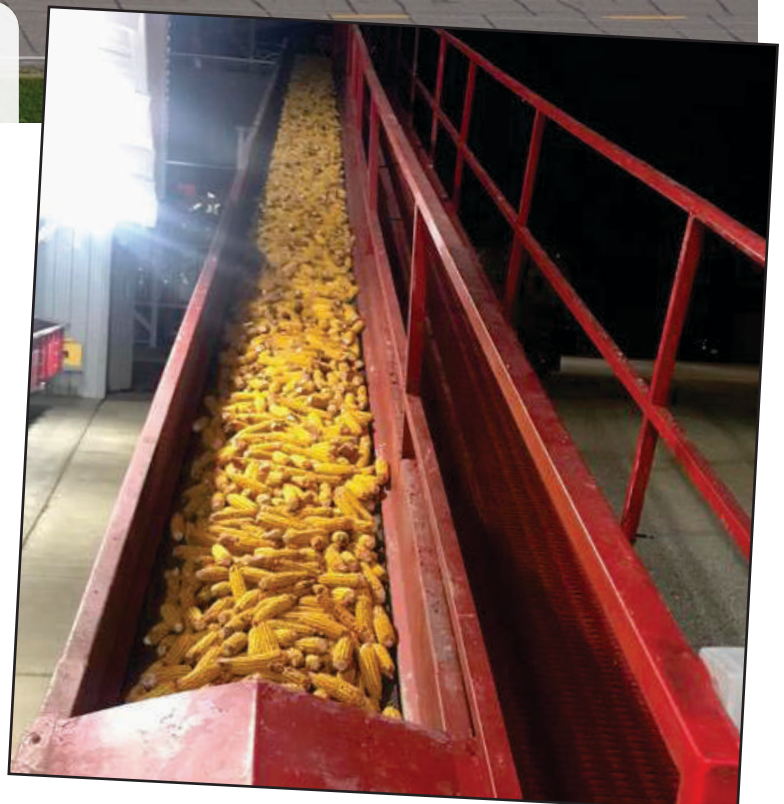
How close our people are who work here. We genuinely know one another.

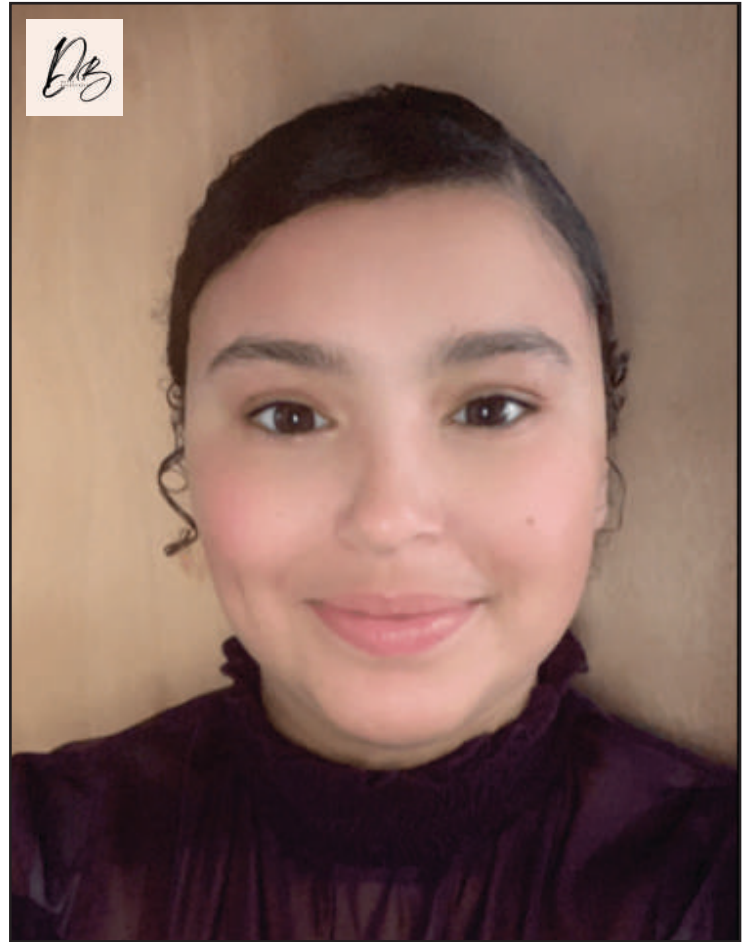
Jordan Davis has a passion for bookkeeping and finance.

Danville Area Community College Launches Hybrid Engineering Degree This Fall

Beginning in Fall 2023, Danville Area Community College (DACC) will begin offering its engineering degree in a hybrid model. The new format allows working students to complete the degree outside of work hours.

“Our engineering program offers the first two years of an engineering degree which consists of mathematics and physics,” says Kathy Sturgeon, Physics and Mathematics Professor. “We have students transfer all over the country, including to the University of Illinois, Rose Hulman, Bradley and more. Two students attended Berkley. Alumni report they are as well, if not better, prepared in mathematics and physics as students who start at the four-year college.”

DACC engineering students have gone on to work for a NASCAR team, CBI, Lockheed-Martin, and CAT. Some have worked on military and NASA projects. Locally, students have been employed by PepsiCo, thyssenkrupp, Watchfire, Fiberteq, and Bunge, to name a few.

DACC offers a unique waiver program that allows students who receive a B or higher in Calculus I to waive tuition for two courses in the

spring. The program saves students over \$1000. The Associate Degree in Engineering program falls under the Math, Sciences and Health Professions Division. This division also offers transfer courses for science and mathematics. Additionally, they

offer Career and Technical Education programs in healthcare (Radiology, Health Information Technology, and Nursing).

Sturgeon says there are personal characteristics that might make someone a good candidate for the



engineering program:

- Enjoys problem-solving.
- Tinkers with things to attempt to understand why they work.
- Appreciates mathematics and science.
- Loves learning.
- Thrives when challenged.

She says the degree offers a wide range of benefits. "Diversity in employment is key," she says. "There are many types of engineering. Once a student chooses a type, there are over seven jobs within that type of engineering. Additionally, engineers can often cross over to other types of work. It is good money too! The average starting salary is near 80K."

The popular professor tells a legendary student story. "I had a student set fire to a paper once because he was unhappy with this grade," she says. "I wasn't pleased at the time, but I can smile now. He

really was a good and fun student."

Having worked at DACC for 24 years, the longtime professor has many other moments she'll remember forever. "Personally, my proudest moment was when an alumnus called me to tell me that he got a leadership scholarship at Carbondale because he had me as an instructor," says Sturgeon. "When asked why he thought he could complete their challenging scholarship program, he answered, 'I had Kathy Sturgeon for physics. If I can complete her course, then I can do anything.' Their answer was, 'We have heard about her. Yes, you are well prepared.' With that said, this young man deserved the scholarship and earned it himself, but it made me feel good.

"Another proud moment was when I got my nickname: The Sturgeonator. I actually found out the students

nicknamed me this on the day I won the DACC Faculty of the Year award." Sturgeon also earned the Illinois Community College Trustees Association Faculty of the Year Award and the national Association of Community College Trustees Meardy Award.
