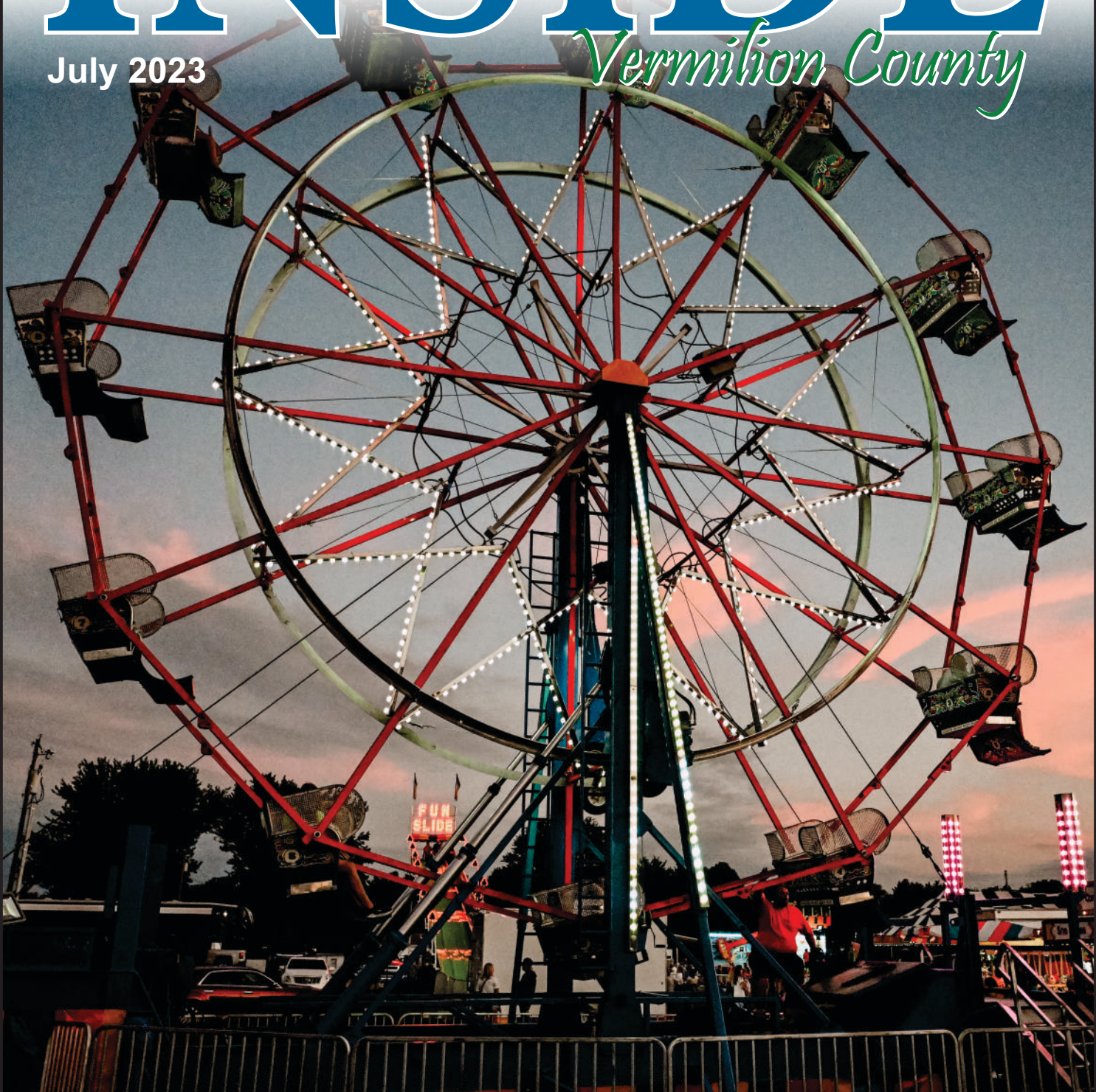

# Global Leadership Summit Set for August 3 & 4 at Second Church of Christ in Danville

The Global Leadership Summit is the premier leadership event of the year, bringing together curious, growth-minded leaders and aspiring leaders, including those who don't yet realize the value of their influence. This two-day catalytic experience features a diverse, world-class faculty delivering fresh, actionable, and inspiring leadership insights and encouragement to a global audience. The event is broadcast in person at hundreds of partnering host site venues.

"This year's theme is *Lead Where You Are*, which focuses on everyone's leadership potential regardless of who you are, what you do, or how old you are," says Dale DeNeal, Executive Minister at Second Church and point person for the GLS. Featured speakers include Condoleezza Rice, Patrick Lencioni, Liz Bohannon, Dave Ramsey, Craig Groeschel, James Clear and many others.

The GLS is set for August 3-4 from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm at Second Church, 3350 E. Voorhees St. Danville, IL. The registration rate is \$199 until July 12. A special rate of \$99 is available for first responders, nurses, active duty military, and students and faculty. Continuing Education Credit may be available for teachers, nurses, and human resource professionals.

Second Church has been involved in the GLS since 2003. "It has so positively impacted and grown our leadership culture that we decided to bring it to Vermilion County so that other organizations could experience its benefit," says DeNeal. "The response and support from the community has been amazing. People come back every year. It's like a family reunion."

Sponsors, or Summit Partners, for the event include Greenwood Inc, Vermilion Advantage, Vermilion County McDonalds, and The Trep School.

DeNeal says the GLS has been a catalyst for uniting the community. "I've seen relationships form and networks grow across multiple sectors such as business, church, education, government, and nonprofit. People are working together with a shared vision and purpose to make Vermilion County an even better place."

Attendance for the GLS averages about 300 people locally, 80,000 nationally and 250,000 globally. The GLS is translated into multiple languages and hosted in Africa, South America, Asia, Europe and the US. The two-day event is hosted at 80 prisons and correctional facilities across North

America, including the Danville Correctional Center. Additionally, Second Church sponsors the GLS through mission partners in Abengourou, Ivory Coast.

DeNeal encourages people not to come alone. "The GLS is a great thing to experience as a team," he says. "We provide space for teams to experience the GLS together. It will help an organization focus their vision and build morale because a team will come away re-charged and inspired."

# G&C Diagnostics: Independent, Discount Laboratory in Hoopeston



Need lab work completed affordably? G&C Diagnostics in Hoopeston can help.

G&C Diagnostics is a discount laboratory serving Hoopeston and the surrounding area. Most of the company's specimens are sent to Quest Diagnostics for processing. They also run several tests in-house and hope to expand onsite testing options soon.

Chellsea Weinard and Elizabeth "Bitsy" Johnson own and operate the company. Weinard is a Certified Phlebotomist. Johnson is a Registered Nurse with 25-plus years of experience.

The lab offers two ways to pay: cash and insurance. "Cash prices are low and affordable," says Weinard. "This is your best option if you don't have insurance or a high deductible. If you pay cash, you can order many tests on your own. For example, if you want to check a cholesterol panel, you come in fasting and tell us you want your cholesterol checked. You pay \$25. No doctor's order or appointment is necessary. Just come during operating

hours. If you want to check your thyroid, tell us you want a basic thyroid screening test. No fasting required; you pay \$35." Cash prices are through G&C Diagnostics. Insurance prices are based on Quest pricing.

G&C Diagnostics has been in business since September 2020.

Weinard and Johnson's experience working for a company that didn't offer insurance fueled the pair's goal of operating an independent lab. "If you have purchased insurance through the marketplace, you understand these plans are not affordable for the working middle class," says Weinard. "Under these plans, lab work was not covered until the deductible was met. After getting a bill for close to \$1,000 for lab work, we began to search for independent labs with lower pricing. The closest was an hour round trip from Hoopeston. That is when we decided to open our own." The two purchased the old Lanie's barber shop at 220 Bank St. and remodeled it with the help of family, especially Uncle Shane Cade.

"We are proud of who we came from and honored to serve the community we grew up in," adds Weinard. "We pride ourselves on being professional and confidential. We will do everything possible to make you feel comfortable."

G&C Diagnostics chose Quest because they are in-network with several local factories. "If you have the Quest Lab Card, the savings are unbeatable," she says. "If you choose to submit through insurance, we charge a \$10 fee to process your sample and send your insurance information to Quest. Quest will then bill your insurance and send you a bill for the remaining balance." Quest pricing is often lower than other options. When using insurance, a physician's order is required.

"We have been surprised by the amount of support we received from local residents," says Weinard. "We were also surprised by how many people traveled from all over the county to use our service. We have regular clients from Danville, Georgetown, Bismarck, Oakwood, and Sidell, to name a few."

# The Slotted Spoon - A Welcome Treat on Gilbert Street in Danville



The Slotted Spoon offers Vermilion County more options for lunch, catering and take-and-bake meals.

The business, located at 401 N. Gilbert Street in Danville, is owned by Eric and Cassie Rhodes.

The Slotted Spoon started in 2018 with take-and-bake meals. In 2022, they added the cafe, more baked goods and catering. Dine-in and carry-out Cafe hours are 11-3 M-F and 11-2 on Saturday. Take & Bake hours are 11-6 M-F, 11-2 on Saturday.

“Our Take & Bake items are homestyle like your grandma used to make,” says Cassie. “Our cafe is a little more contemporary with specialty cheeses, mixed greens and homemade dressings. Our Take & Bake menu changes on the 1st of every month. Chicken Pot Pie is our best seller and the only thing that doesn't come off the menu. Our most popular cafe item

is our Turkey Panini on house-made focaccia bread with chipotle mayo.”

The Rhodes decided to expand in 2022 because Cassie always dreamed of having a lunch cafe with excellent baked goods. The business, which had only 900 square feet before the move, also needed more space for the Take & Bake preparation.

Along with a full dine-in or take-out lunch menu, unique offerings include special holiday items and new catering services, from cafe lunches to a full-service buffet.

“The best part of the business is the people,” says Cassie. “We have become friends with so many of our customers. I love the small-town feel of Danville and all the area towns. Everyone has been so supportive. Having a dream doesn't mean it makes for a good business. It's always

a risk. Vermilion County has been so accepting of our food and business. We would be nothing without all the support of our community.”

Cassie's Vermilion County roots run deep. She remembers her “granny” making the rolls and desserts at George's Buffet for 20 years. Her grandpa would take her along to sell corn from his garden at the farmers' market. “We spent a lot of time growing up with our grandparents,” she says. “They took the time to cook with us and teach us about fresh ingredients from the garden. We try and keep our food simple but good, just like we were taught.”

The Slotted Spoon is truly a family-run business. “My sister, Courtney and cousin, Kristen, have been a part of the kitchen since the first year,” she says. “Several nieces and nephews worked with us, as well as both of our daughters. Out of our nine employees, six are family. Well, really, we are just one big family!”

Get ready for one of Vermilion County's favorite events! The Georgetown Fair will be held July 8 - 15, 2023. In addition to a full slate of rides, events and entertainment, the fair is hosting Vermilion County 4-H shows on the grounds.

Daily fair events include livestock shows, carnival rides, Home Ec/Ag Produce and 4-H Exhibits and commercial buildings open each evening for people to view projects.

Saturday, July 15, is Kiddie Day and will feature a pretty baby contest at 9 a.m. and a Kid's Pedal Tractor Pull at noon. Sunday, July 9, features a Gospel Sing and Ice Cream Social.

The carnival runs Tuesday, July 11, through Saturday, July 15. All rides are open from 6 p.m to close. and require only one ticket. This year, the carnival will have an armband night every night of the week. "In years past, we've only been able to offer it for three nights," says Georgetown Fair Board President Don Hackler. "This is exciting and will allow families to get armbands during our pre-sale to save money. If they don't get armbands in advance, they can purchase them at the carnival ticket booth."

During the pre-sale, armbands are \$15 each. The week of the fair, armbands will be \$25 each. Individual tickets are also available for purchase.

Livestock Exhibits and Advanced Home Ec & Ag Produce Entries are due by Wednesday, July 5.

While Hackler serves as Georgetown Fair Board President, all 24 board members take on different roles throughout the year. Everyone is all hands on deck during fair week. Many

The business has changed through the years with various remodels, additions, and automation of watering and climate controls. The changes help with consistency and growing better plants.

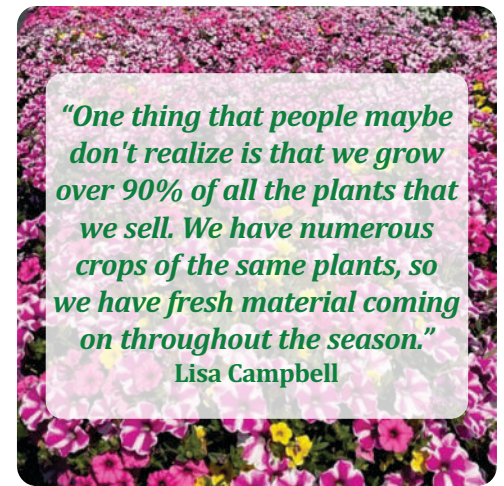


Customer service is the name of the game for the Campbells and their team. "We strive to help everyone become a better gardener," they say.
