

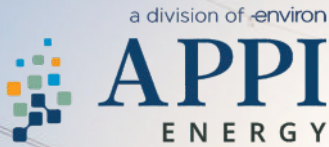

Hoopeston Area Women Making a Difference: Supporting Vermilion County

Want to make Vermilion County better and have fun while you're doing it? Consider joining Hoopeston Area Women Making a Difference.

Hoopeston Area Women Making a Difference is a group of women aged 18 and older. The organization aims to provide volunteer and financial support to charities and organizations in Vermilion County. The group hosts fundraisers throughout the year to help others.

The club was initially called Professional Business Women. In 2001, the group became an independent organization with a new name to serve Vermilion County better.

"I think people would be surprised how much fun we have, even picking up trash!" says Traci Jones, Club Vice President and Public Relations Chairwoman. "It truly is a great group of women!"

The club has 38 members, with women ranging in age from their 20s

to 80s. Members are asked to serve on at least one of the group's 11 committees.

Annual membership is \$25.00. The group offers four types of membership:

- Active - participation in meetings, committees, fundraising, and activities.
- Honorary/Social - welcome at all meetings and social events but not eligible to vote.
- Student - high school senior who donates her time to at least one activity and attends at least one meeting, non-voting.
- Patron - person or organization that provides a contribution exceeding the amount of annual dues, non-voting.

Annual events include assisting with Trees for Trash community cleanup, hosting a dinner for the Sweetheart contestants during the Sweet Corn Festival, helping other organizations with their events, and participating in the Labor Day Parade.

Hoopeston Area Women Making a Difference hosts two to four fundraisers throughout the year. Two annual events are the late fall Community Raffle, where participants purchase tickets to win one of three monthly cash prizes, and the Vendor Fair. "This event has been a great success," says Jones. "The Vendor Fair is open to craft and direct sales vendors. This year's Vendor Fair will be held on September 23rd from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM at the First Church of God in Hoopeston. Entrance fee is a monetary donation or canned good we give to the church."

The group also gives gifts and time to multiple organizations and collects items for nursing homes, shelters and other places with a need. Programs and causes the group supports include the American Legion Gifts to Yanks program, Crosspoint Women's Shelter, Grant Township Food Cupboard, Hoopeston Multi-Agency, holiday gifts, and many more. The group also awards scholarships to Hoopeston Area senior girls.

The group meets at 6 PM on the 4th Tuesday of each month at the Mason's Star Lodge.

Tess Cook Named Airport Manager at Vermilion Regional Airport

There is a new face at the Vermilion Regional Airport. In June, Tess Cook became the new airport manager.

As airport manager, Cook works with many different state organizations to ensure the safety and security of the airport. "The airport is a piece of the national airspace infrastructure, and our job, as caretakers of the airport, is to ensure that anyone who wants to use the airport can," she says. "That could be for public use if someone wants to use the airport as a landing spot for an event they envision or for transient pilots flying for many different reasons."

"I hope to help the airport, plane and simple, pun intended. We want to update, modify, and restore different aspects, but the goals are to ensure everything works and the tenants and visitors have a positive experience." Tess Cook

Before assuming her new role, Cook worked as a drone pilot to identify airfield distresses. "We sent the PCI score back to the airport to identify where their money needed to go next and to provide further information to the Federal Aviation Administration and the US Department of Transportation when requesting funding for airport projects," Cook says. She also completed an internship with the US Department of Health and Human Services that provided her with experience in how government entities protect their assets and ensure the security of their information. She graduated from Embry Riddle Aeronautical University in Prescott, Arizona. She also has over 100 hours as a student pilot, which has helped her understand the airside information in her new position.

She has a welcoming message for everyone in the community. "We are here for you! The airport is a public commodity, and we would love to have more visitors join us to learn more about aviation. We have a Flight Club and an Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) chapter. You don't have to be a pilot or have any aviation background to attend those; you only need curiosity."



Cook and her team have big plans for the airport. "We would love to get back to the status of airport of the year, which we had in 2014," she says. "I would love for the airport to be a main partner with the city and help ensure the city's economic development. We also want more traffic and airfield events here in the future, such as the Air Race Classic or an Airshow."

A question about why she chose her career field elicits a chuckle. "The perspective and feeling of flight is indescribable," she says. "It's amazing once you are in the air and in control of the aircraft. It's terrifying. It's exciting. It's new territory you are traversing! Now granted, my flying has taken a back seat, but I want to stay in the world of people who are committed to the feeling they get when flying. I got into this field because of the experience of flight, and I stayed in the industry because of the commitment to safety and the passionate people involved."

As you'd expect, she has a great passion for all aircraft and especially loves the Midwest Aero Restorations classic and vintage restored planes at the airport. "We have such a wide range of aircraft that stop by, and all of them are unique in their own ways! We cover quite the spectrum of regulars, from classic restored aircraft to crop dusters, to small general aviation aircraft, to gliders and balloons."

While she's still exploring Vermilion County, Cook has been incredibly impressed with the local commitment to Danville Area Community College. "I took a year of community college courses before finishing my degree, and I don't think enough people take advantage of their local community colleges or even support them the way Danville does," she says.

Norah's Smokehouse offers delivery straight from the truck. Food delivery is available via Door Dash through the company's website, norahs-smokehouse.square.site.

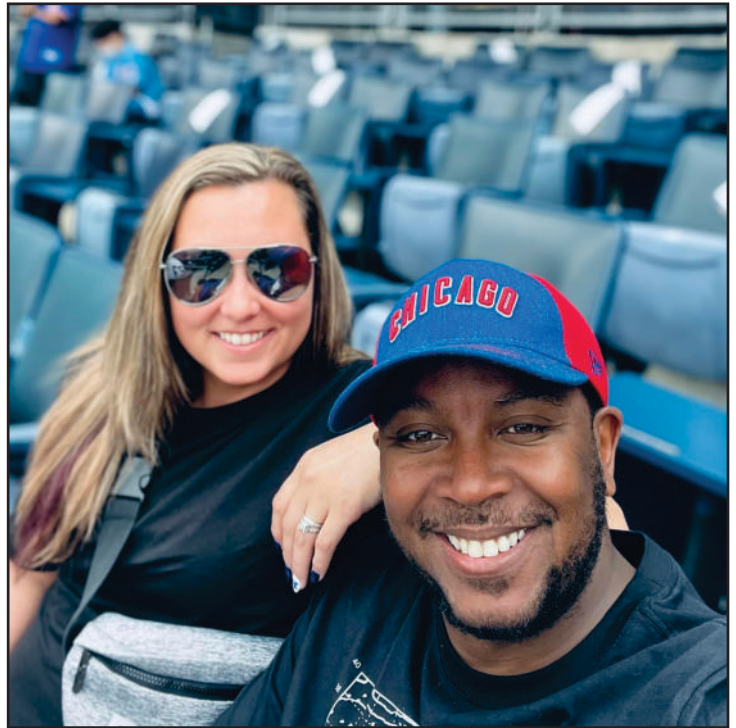
Guests enjoyed the food truck at this year's Balloons Over Vermilion. "This is an event we love to attend," says Kasara. "It was nice to be a vendor this year."

After Mike's unexpected job loss last August, the pair set out for Texas in September to purchase a new mobile kitchen. By the end of October, they were set up at the Covered Bridge. "We were the only newbies on the Hill Top," they recall. "It took us one full hour to build up the courage to open the window for orders. Our anxiety was through the roof. It was our first event, and it was a 10-day event. This event really prepared us for

the future. Now, we get excited when we have long lines at the truck these days. We take a lot of pride in what we do and what goes out the window."

Danville Dans Celebrate Historic Win



The Danville Dans are celebrating their 1,000th win. According to the team's research, no other collegiate team has won more games.

The Danville Dans are co-owned by Jeanie Cooke and Rick Kurth. Cooke is the General Manager of the Dans and is a member of the Prospect League Board of Directors. Kurth is President and handles the day-to-day operations of the Dans. The team's sales director is Greg Wolfe.

"The 1000 victories are the work of many fine people in Vermilion County spanning from 1988 through the present year," says Kurth. "This includes former members, staff, coaches, and players. This success would not have occurred if it wasn't for the support of the Mayors of the City of Danville. A definite contributing factor to the 1000 wins is our current Coach, Eric Coleman, who has contributed 300 plus victories to this total over the last 10 years."

The Danville Dans have about seven paid interns and one full-time paid grounds keeper, depending on the event. Seventeen teams comprise the

league representing Pennsylvania, Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Tennessee and Iowa.

The team plays at Danville Stadium, which was built by the people of Danville. The team's name is a nod of gratitude to the town's citizens. The existing Danville Dans team name was copied from an earlier minor league team that played at Danville Stadium.

The team's players are from the Prospect League, formerly the Central Illinois Collegiate League. All players are student-athletes from colleges all over the country. "They are sent to us by their college coaches, so as in all business, it is about relationships with those coaches," says Cooke. "We are a development league that helps players hone their skills using wooden bats. Thirty-five of our Dans have or are playing major league baseball, and others play in minor leagues. Four were selected in this year's draft."

The Danville Dans organization is nationally identified with Vermilion County. "The team is well known, and well respected, from coast to coast for its beautiful historic stadium, for its

success on the field, and for producing successful individuals as well as baseball players," says Kurth. "Second and third generation fans now attend the games on a regular basis."

Dans games provide a welcoming atmosphere at a reasonable cost for residents of Danville, Vermilion County, and the surrounding areas. "It also brings in players and fans from all over the country (as far as Hawaii) to help bring in tourism dollars and spread the good news about our community," explains Cooke, who is also the director of the Danville Area Visitors Bureau.

Benefits and How to Support the Team

Among the many benefits of the local team are the pride it inspires in residents and the positive impact on non-residents. "It is a great family atmosphere and a great place to gather and socialize," says Wolfe. "It is also great wood bat baseball and a competitive team."

Wolfe is working to increase sponsorships with area businesses. "Our operating costs continue to increase, and we must increase our business partnerships to keep things running," he says. Tarquini's Offering Fresh Produce and Seasonal Market

It's worth the short drive to Perrysville, Indiana, to enjoy Tarquini's, a local treasure off the beaten path. Andrea (Andi) Tarquini and her husband, Rob Williamson, own and operate the business.

Tarquini's is a fresh produce and seasonal market located at 402 N Jackson St in Perrysville, Indiana. This year marks the company's 5th season in business.

Tarquini's starts its year with fresh asparagus in April, followed by May retail sales, which include a large assortment of flowers and hanging baskets. June kicks off the produce season, where fresh items such as lettuce, radishes, strawberries, peaches, and blueberries become available. The company's primary season is July and August when approximately 3,000 plants are harvested on-site to sell at their retail location. Tarquini's also makes

multiple weekly trips to provide their customers with southern Indiana watermelon, cantaloupe and sweet corn. Their final, beautiful season includes a massive selection of mums & pumpkins in September.

Most of their items are grown on-site. This small family business grows thousands of hanging baskets and harvests approximately 3,000 veggie plants locally.

Tarquini's operates much like an "Open Daily" farmers market. Their fields are harvested daily, and that day's products are available for purchase. While this may mean certain products sell out, they take pride in offering fresh food that has never been in cold

storage, shipped or packed and was picked that morning. "Tarquini's also promises never to sell a hot house-grown tomato," says Andi. "We stick to only selling garden-grown, fresh tomatoes. There is SUCH a difference in taste!"

Each season has a "hot" item, according to Andi.

- April - Asparagus
- May - Hanging Baskets
- June - Strawberries & Peaches
- July - Sugar Baby Watermelon & Sweet Corn
- August - Garden-Grown Tomatoes
- September - \$5 Mums & Pumpkins

Seasonal events include a Mother's Day Event the Saturday before the holiday. This year the event featured over 50 vendors and drew approximately 5,000 people to Perrysville, IN. They look forward to hosting their 3rd Mother's Day Event in May 2024.

"Every day or weekend feels like an event at Tarquini's because in-season inventory changes daily," says Andi. "The excitement of 'what's-to-come' never gets old and keeps our customers interested in returning for whatever may be next!"

The idea of supporting local businesses is critical to Tarquini's success.





"Because of the wonderful people of Vermilion/Vermillion counties, small businesses are able to thrive here!" she says.

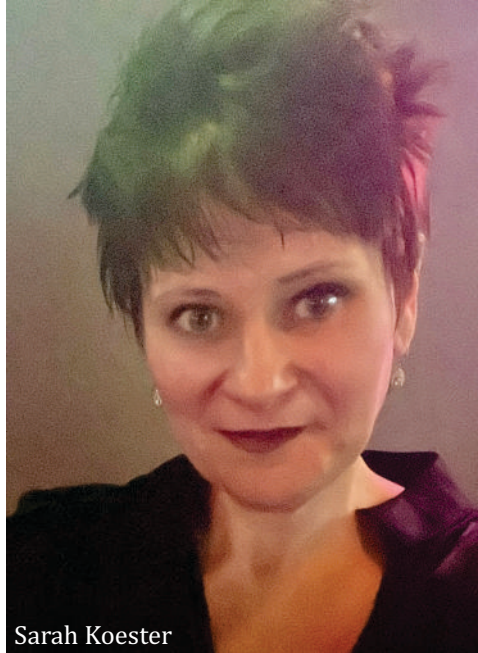

The 708 Mental Health Board, in partnership with Gateway Family Services of Illinois and the Illinois Children's Healthcare Foundation, is bringing *Rising Tide* back to Danville on October 6th & 7th at the Dick Van Dyke Auditorium. The previous Rising Tide Conference in 2021 brought in professionals from 14 different states and was broadcast in over 13 co-host sites worldwide.

The event is the brainchild of Michael Remole, MA, LCPC, NCC, NCL-C, EP, CEO & Founder Gateway Family Services of Illinois, Founder of the Rising Tide Conference.

Rising Tide will include nearly 30 expert presenters from all around the world, including six keynote presenters--Bruce D. Perry MD, Ph.D. (co-author with Oprah Winfrey of the New York Bestselling book, "What Happened To You?"); Stephen Porges Polyvagal Institute, Ph.D.; Melissa Merrick, Ph.D., CEO of Prevent Child Abuse America; J. Stuart Ablon, Ph.D., THINK: KIDS; Alex Kajitani, California Teacher of the Year; and 2016 World Series MVP, Ben Zobrist, who will share his mental health journey.

Event partners include United Way, 708 Mental Health Board, Illinois Children's Healthcare Foundation, Danville Area Visitors Bureau, CrossPoint Human Services, iGrow, and Danville District 118.

This year, Rising Tide launches on Thursday, October 5th, with the EQUUS Film Festival, hosted at Gateway Family Services in Potomac. This powerful film festival will show multiple documentaries about how horses are helping people find healing.
