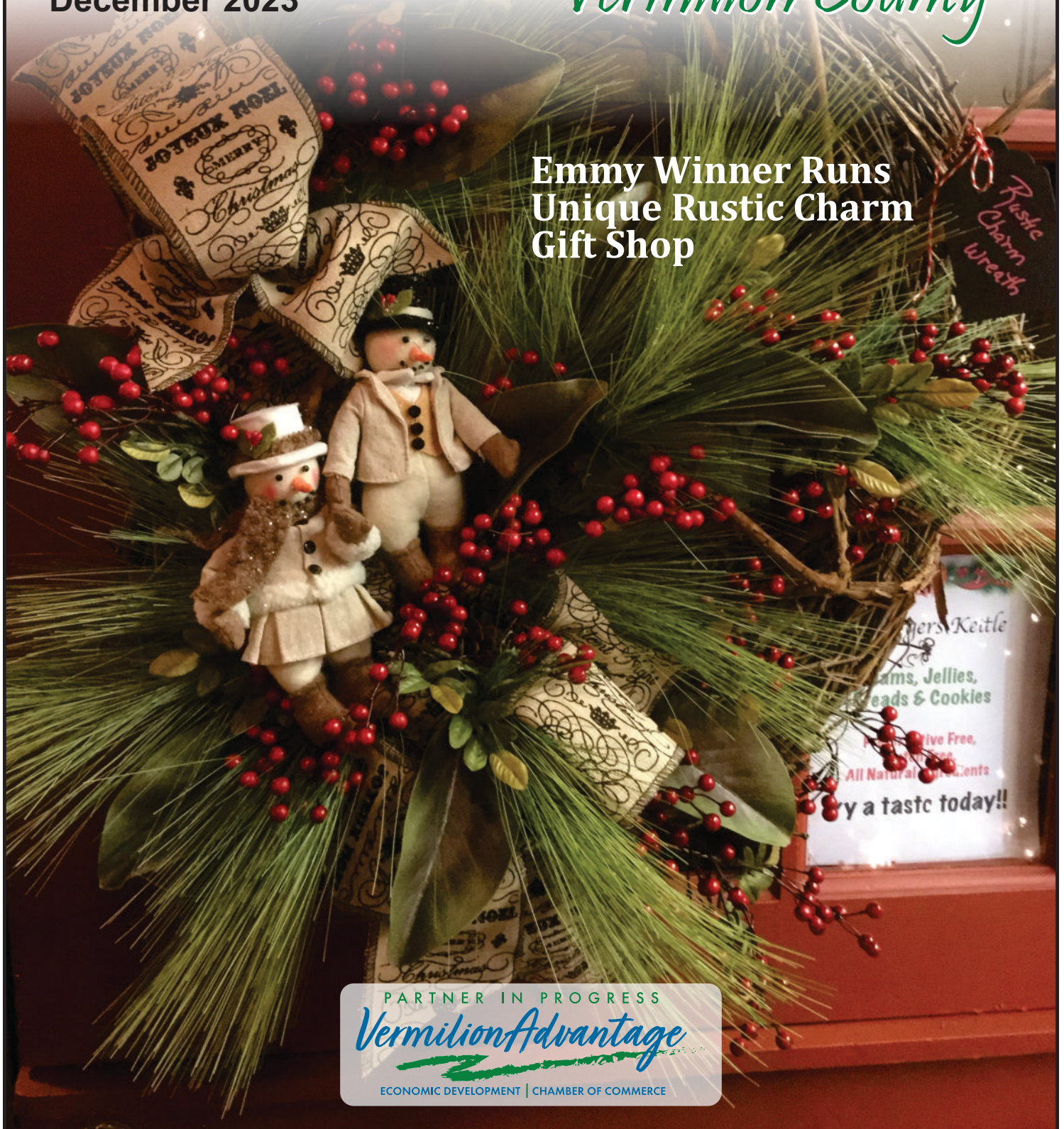

# thyssenkrupp Dynamic Components & DACC Welding Program Create Beneficial Partnership

thyssenkrupp Dynamic Components (tkDC) is an integral part of the area's employment base, supplying high-quality camshafts for the international automotive industry. To produce the camshafts, tkDC's Danville plant relies on globally sourced lobes, which are stored in sturdy steel containers. Acquiring these containers is challenging in the best of times. Recently, the situation was exacerbated when the company received about 100 defective containers, making it difficult to store the lobes in the warehouse securely. Repairing the defective containers was the most sustainable and best solution. After researching repair options, tkDC determined the answer to their dilemma was close to home.

## Enter Danville Area Community College (DACC).

"The collaboration between DACC and thyssenkrupp is a beneficial partnership where DACC welding students gain valuable skills and experience by repairing containers, while

thyssenkrupp benefits from the problem-solving and assistance provided by the students," says Julie Cunningham, Buyer, Procurement and Supply Management – Automotive Technology – Dynamic Components, thyssenkrupp Danville plant.

"The thyssenkrupp steel totes needed repair," explains R.J. Rowland, DACC welding instructor. "We thought it would be a good exercise for students to put their welding skills to practical use."

The repaired containers reduce waste and enable thyssenkrupp to store its products efficiently.

"DACC students both enhance their skills and assist thyssenkrupp in resolving the issue of defective steel containers, contributing to a sustainable solution for us," says Cunningham. "Our partnership makes it possible to mutually support the students' long-term development and promote cooperation that represents added value for both sides."

## thyssenkrupp Gives Back

To thank DACC, thyssenkrupp recently made a \$3,000 gift to the DACC Foundation. The donation aims to support DACC's mission of providing high-quality education materials to more students and is one of the many ways tkDC gives back to the community.

"We appreciate creating relationships with the local manufacturers that connect them with our students," says Rowland. "This partnership helps prepare our students to be productive members of the workforce."

The welding program at DACC is a two-semester certificate program. A welding certificate can be earned in one semester, and the Advanced Welding Certificate takes an additional semester.

Alan Baldwin, Co-Owner of MASH-C Farms Livestock, LLC., comes from a long line of Vermilion County farmers. On both sides of his family, farming goes back six generations. This longtime history is why he and his father founded their beef cattle business.

MASH-C Farms Livestock is located in Ridge Farm, IL, where they raise beef cattle. They sell quarter, half, and whole freezer beef, and ground beef by the pound a few times a year.

High-quality beef and genuine care for their customers are what set the company apart. "We work with our customers and their financial situation so they can attain quality beef for their homes," says Alan. "This is an area with many hard-working people. Taking advantage of them and overcharging is not an option for us. We have several of our customers on a payment plan so they can better afford the product."

*"We are here to serve you. We want to provide quality beef to the people of our local communities at affordable prices. We aren't in this line of work to get rich. We are here to be that reliable family farm that won't take advantage of you, that has good food for good families." Alan Baldwin*

People might be pleasantly surprised when they use the company's robust website. Customers and visitors can find butcher dates, the farm's history, pictures of the farm and cattle, and make and pay for beef orders.

"One thing I would like people to know is we are family-owned and very family-oriented," says Alan. "My dad, and fellow co-owner of MASH-C Farms, is a huge inspiration to me. My dad has been around cattle his entire life, so I trust his knowledge. Plus, I have watched that man work harder than anyone I know to support his family. Seeing this during my childhood, and even into my adult life, has motivated me to be the same way for my family."

Community involvement has always been important to the Baldwin family and is a big reason they choose to raise beef. For the past three years, MASH-C Farms has sponsored Georgetown baseball/softball teams and



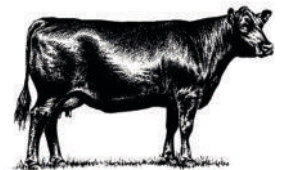
supported other Georgetown school functions. Every year, they try to donate a couple of quarters of beef to local organizations for money-raising raffles. The local organizations include Thunder on the Ridge, Georgetown Masons, and Ms. Holly's House. The company also partners with the Eastern Illinois Foodbank to provide beef for local food giveaways.

Alan believes Vermilion County's greatest strengths are hard work, ethics, community pride, and a recognition of quality. "In Vermilion County, if there is a small business with a great quality product, they will have the residents' loyalty," he says.

# Fischer Theatre: Ready for the Next Chapter



Few things have energized the Vermilion County area more than seeing the marquee light up at the Fischer Theatre in downtown Danville. The reopening catalyzed downtown's rebirth and launched a renewed passion for charting the next phase of community development. We recently caught up with the man behind the lights, Executive Director Jason Rome.

**Tell us a bit about the theatre's history.** Although most folks remember the Fischer as a movie theatre, it began life on November 5th, 1884, as the Grand Opera House! The theatre transitioned to a vaudeville stage, a movie palace and ultimately the property of a national movie theater chain before being abandoned in 1981. This was the year the Vermilion Heritage Foundation formed to save and restore the theatre. Even with the help of Danville's past celebrities returning home to raise funds, it was when Julius W. Hegeler II began investing in the restoration effort that the theatre could reopen in 2019. Unfortunately, Mr. Hegeler passed before the restoration could be completed, but by borrowing funds

and securing additional donations, "The Lady" reopened on September 21st, 2019, with a sold-out show. The Fischer is one of America's oldest operating theatres, a member of the League Of Historic American Theatres, and proudly on the National Registry of Historic Places.

**What is the Vermilion Heritage Foundation?** VHF is the 501(c)3 nonprofit organization that owns and operates the historic Fischer Theatre. VHF has managed to not only keep the doors open despite gaps in funding and a global pandemic that shuttered

the doors of most small venues but has grown the programming and operation responsibly and continues to prepare for the continued restoration to ensure the theatre will never go dark again.

**What events are coming before the end of 2023?** We'll see the return of The Lettermen on December 2<sup>nd</sup> for a Christmas special. We also work with local organizations, so stay tuned for live performances from groups like the Danville Barbershop Chorus and more.

**What have been some of the most memorable events and projects so far?** I was a huge fan of the Pitch Meeting band - some of the best Nashville musicians presenting Music City's #1 open mic night for up-and-coming artists—and the Paragon Ragtime Orchestra. This national orchestra plays 1920s music on period instruments.

The work we did to help build our community's local arts organizations and the opportunities we've created for local school children to also grow on our stage will be those I'm most



proud of. Artists come and go, but the impact we have on our community and the benefit we can bring to our neighbors and our next generation are why I continue to punch the clock.

**Talk to us about the restoration work.** There are some very basic things, like the building is structurally sound. But the rejuvenated plasterwork in the auditorium and the handicap-accessible front doors and restrooms are things that most visitors notice and admire. The best part is that all the work helps highlight the natural acoustics and amazing views from any seat in the house.

**What restoration is still to come?** Here are the projects we are currently developing for future action: restoring or constructing functional dressing rooms, restoring or constructing a modern grid system above the stage, adding functional line sets to that grid, renovating our concessions and bar service, upgrading the refurbished seats in the auditorium, and restoring the third and fourth floors of the front addition.

**How can someone get involved?** Consider volunteering as an usher for

one of our events or serving on our board or committees. Donors and sponsors are also very appreciated and necessary. Your dollars will help us grow the quality and quantity of our programming - and increase their ripple effect on our community and local economy.

**Anything we haven't asked?** I would emphasize that the Fischer isn't fully restored, we weren't left money to operate the theatre, and we are a standalone entity that does not receive regular funding from any other organization or source. We would love to have your help!

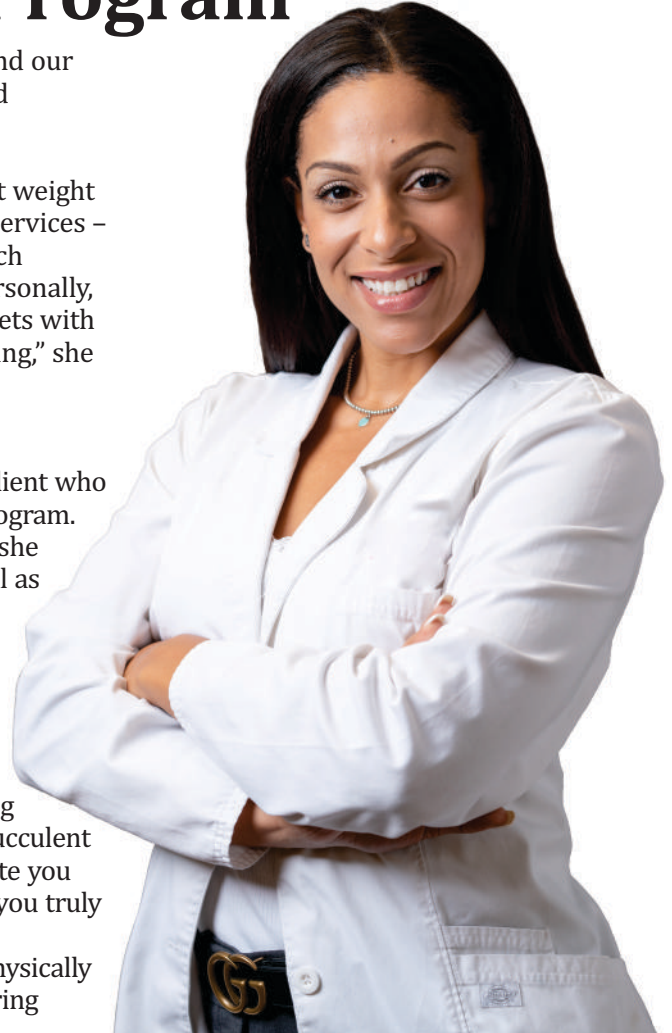
with each client individually, and our patients value the empathy and relatability I offer."

# My Happy Place Empowering People to Improve Neighborhoods

Any resident who wants to improve their neighborhood would benefit from learning more about My Happy Place. The nonprofit organization is on a mission to empower neighbors and accelerate nonprofits in their pursuit of thriving communities.

Natasha Elliott is the President of My Happy Place. Crystal Hicks serves as board treasurer, and Sophia Baker is secretary.

The idea for the nonprofit started when Natasha and a few friends were discussing the potential for residents to be viable partners in the community development process. "The city has been working to abate nuisances and to bring new businesses to the area," she says. "Local nonprofit organizations work daily to provide many other specific services. We thought it might be good to help residents meet these institutions halfway and leverage those investments to create the type of neighborhood they desire."

My Happy Place provides urban planning and organizational management tools to residents who wish to improve their neighborhoods. For no cost, residents can have an urban planner or organizational manager dispatched to their neighborhood. The planner can assist with mapping assets and crafting a plan based on the resident's vision for the area. She and her team believe Vermilion County brings unlimited potential to launch new and exciting ideas. "We hope to build relationships with like-minded individuals and organizations to maximize our ability to serve in the area," she says.
