The three winners are pictured at right, with their winning designs above.

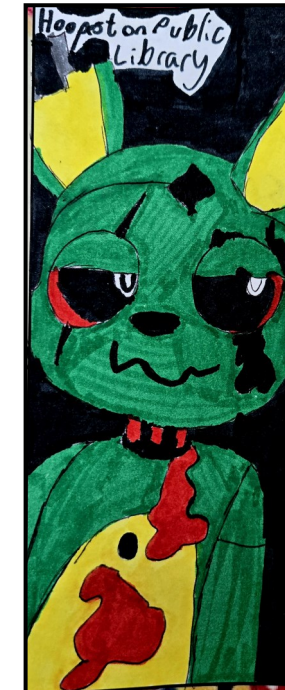
Each winner received a \$10 gift card from Boxcar Books & Vinyl. Their bookmarks will be printed and available to patrons later this spring.
