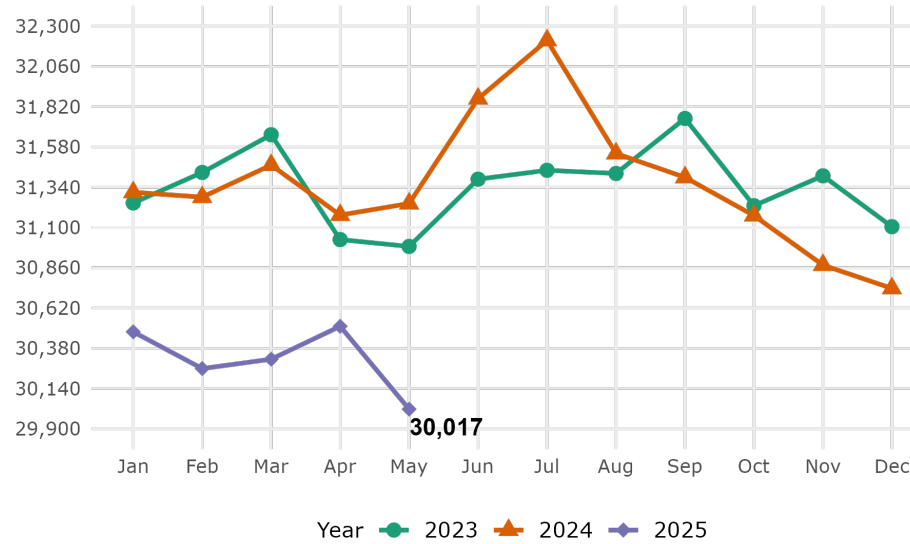

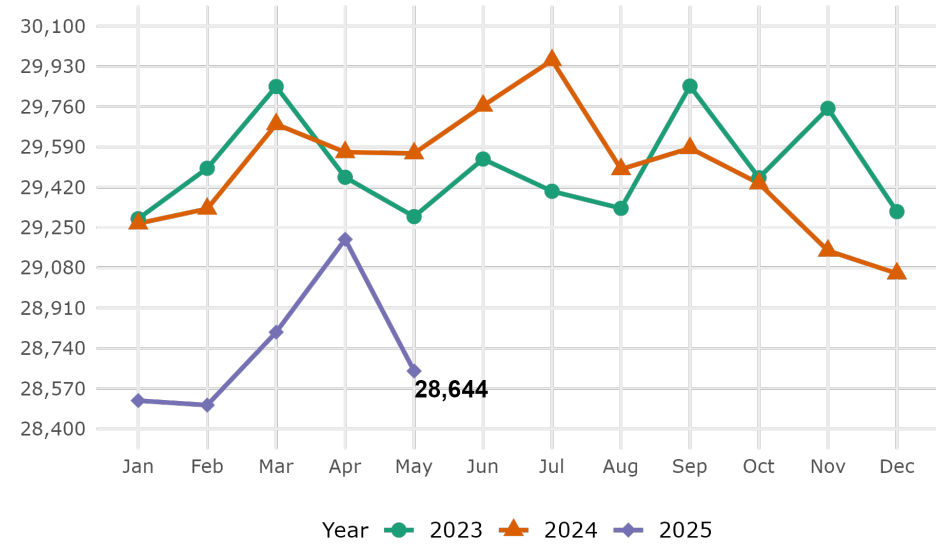

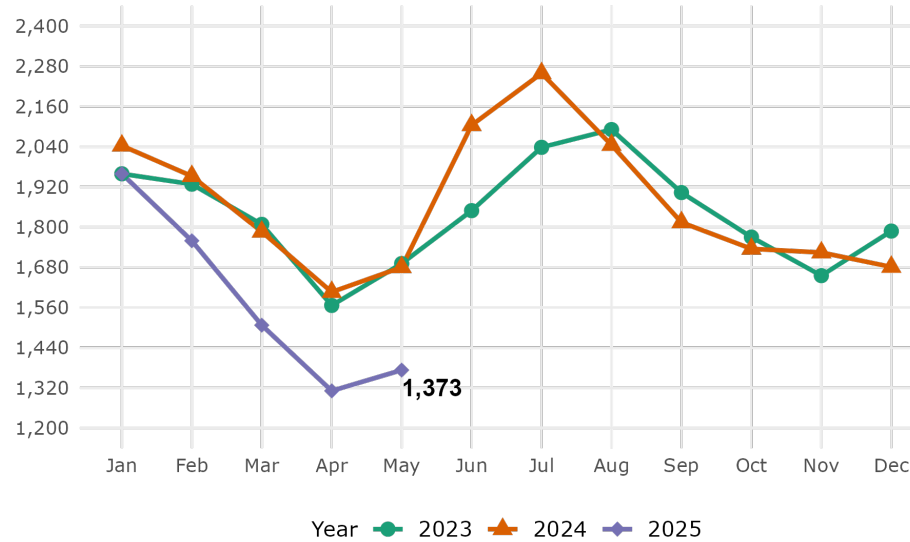
Total Labor Force



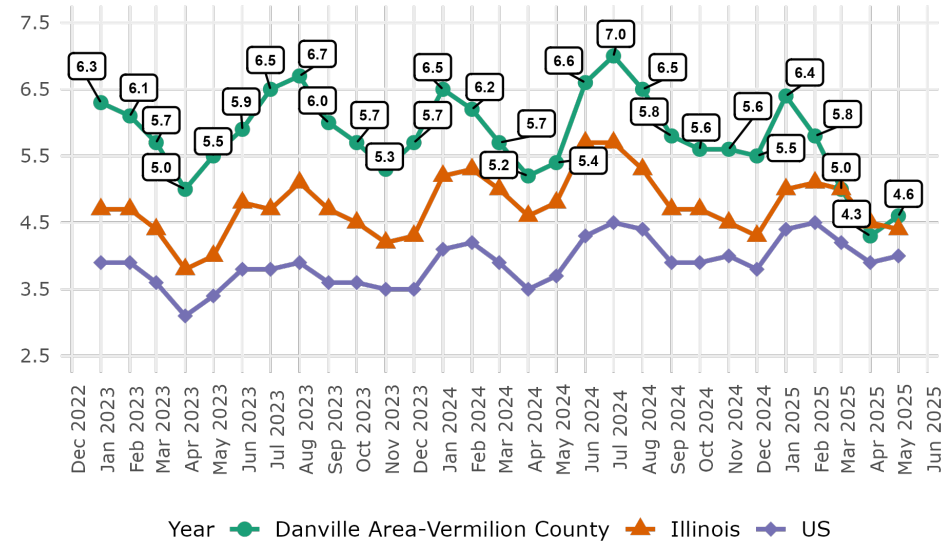
Employed

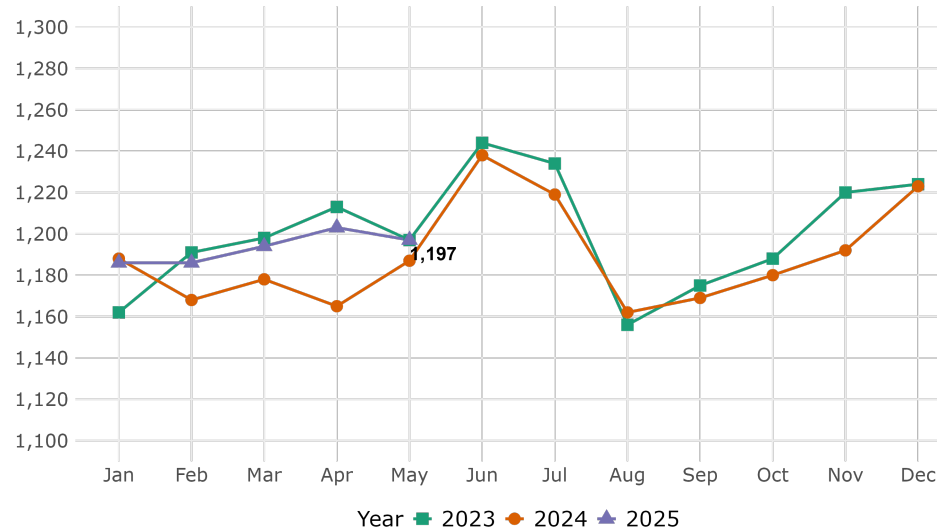

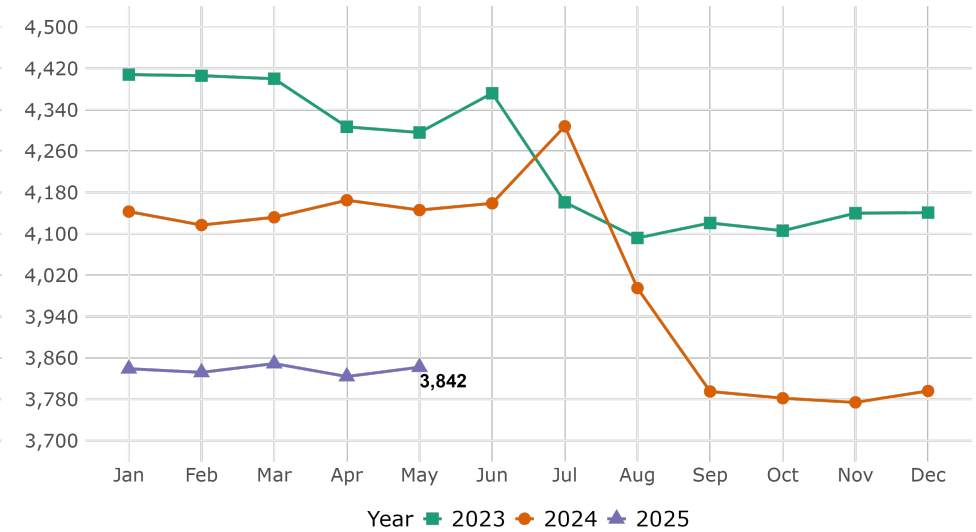
Danville Area - LWIA 18, Employment by Industry

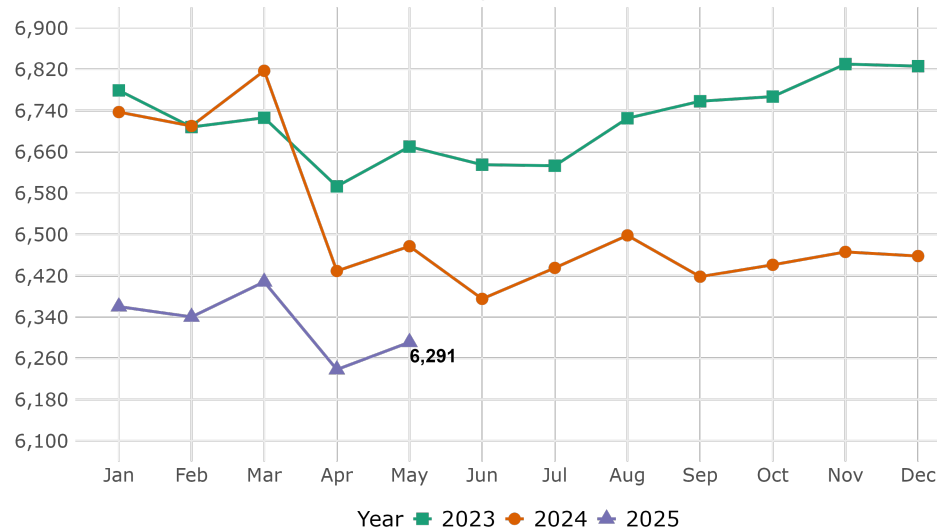

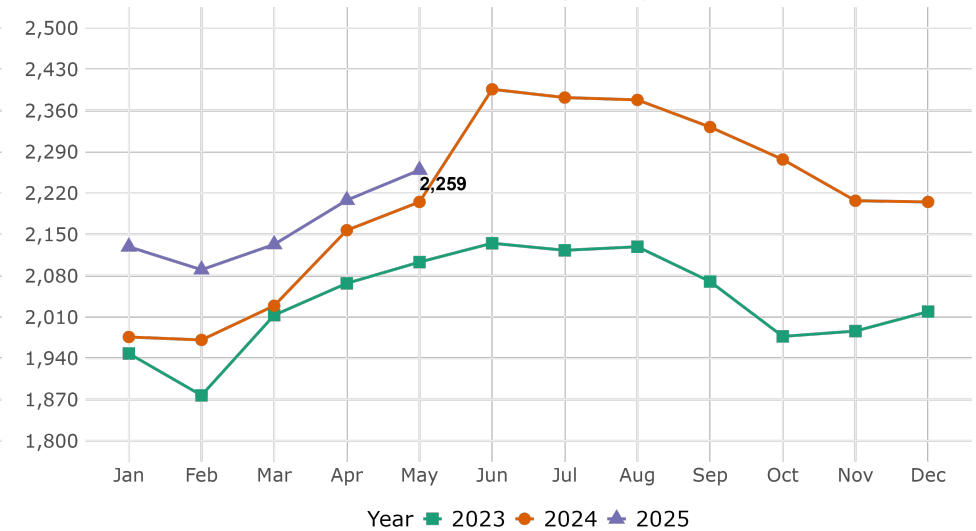
Manufacturing



Trade-Transportation-Utilities

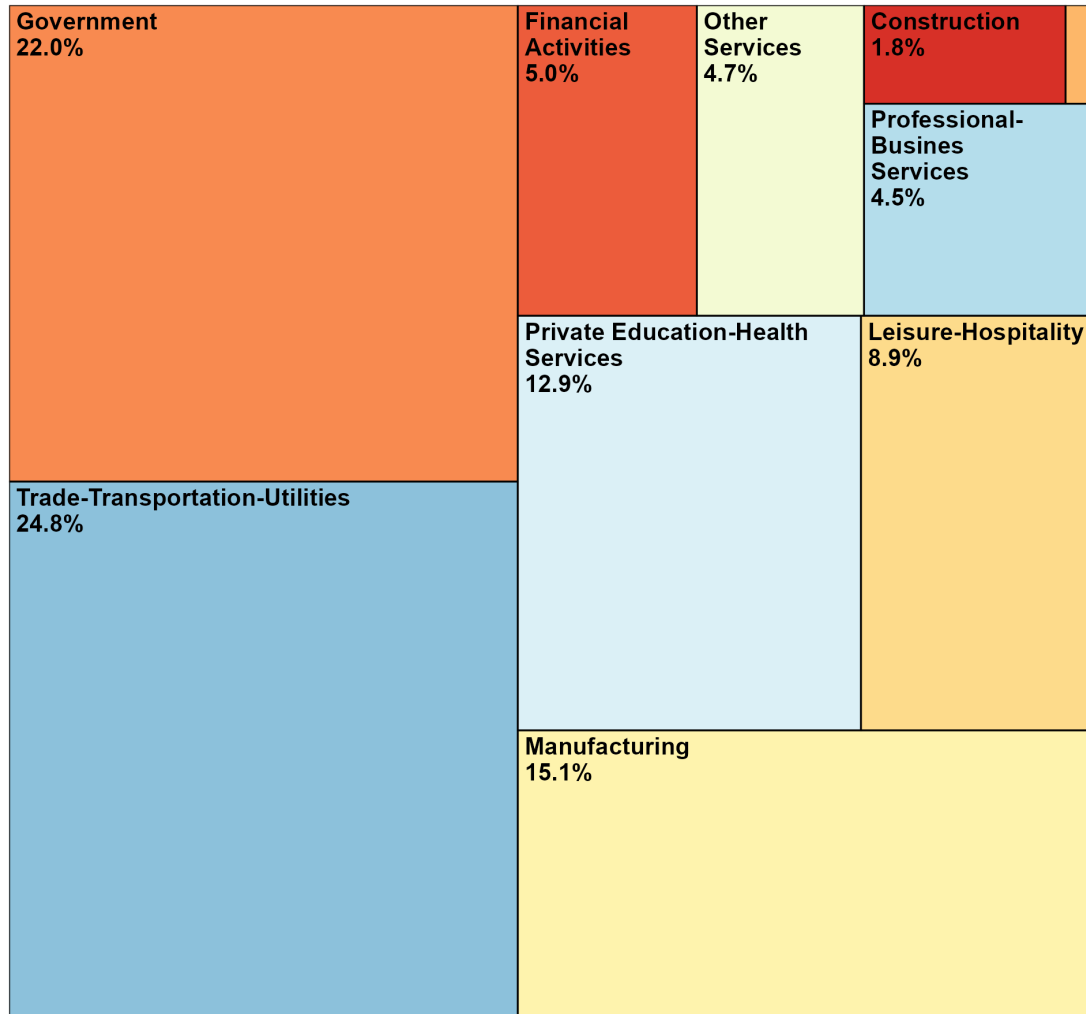
